

## **2010 Weinstein Memorial Award presented to the Kuhlman's**

The Glenbard South Booster Organization is pleased to announce the winners of the 2010 Jerry Weinstein Memorial Award. The Weinstein Award recognizes dedication, commitment and extraordinary achievement in support of the Glenbard South students and community, as modeled by the late Jerry Weinstein, Glenbard South's first Booster president. The 2010 winners are Judy and Tom Kuhlman.

The Kuhlman's joined the Boosters in 1996 when their oldest child started freshman year at Glenbard South. Judy served on the Executive Board for six years, serving as secretary for one year and as treasurer for two two-year terms. The Kuhlman's served as Co-Presidents with Anne Marie and Bob Wall in 2000-01, and helped to usher in several new events and projects. A major undertaking was fundraising for the lights on the football field. Judy chaired the fashion show and publicity committees, and the Kuhlman's served on numerous other committees.

Whether hosting pasta dinners for sports teams or serving on the Booster Executive Board, the Kuhlman's tried to help out wherever there was a need. Their most significant contributions occurred during the years of the referendum campaigns when they worked successfully with the Booster Executive Board, Booster members and Glenbard South administration to provide financial support to minimize the loss of sports and other extra-curricular activities. Many activities are still in place today because they were not cut during that time.

Throughout their many years of service, the Kuhlman's demonstrated a high level of integrity, enthusiasm and support for students and the community. The Weinstein Award was presented to Judy and Tom Kuhlman during a halftime ceremony at the Glenbard South homecoming football game on October 1, 2010.
